### **Definition Spreader**

A submission from the Chairman of the Equipment Committee

## Purpose or Objective

To clarify the wording of the rules. To provide consistency with regards to the usage of the words "attached to" and "connected to".

### Proposal

Amend ERS F.1.4 and F.1.5 as follows:

- F.1.4 Spar Types
  - (c) HULL SPARS

A spar attached to the hull.

(iii) DECK SPREADER

A hull spar extending transversely to attach connect standing rigging.

### F.1.5 Spreader

Equipment used to brace a **spar**, attached at one end to the **spar** and <u>connected at</u> the other end to **rigging**, <del>and</del> working in compression when in use.

#### **Current Position**

As above.

#### Reason

To clarify that a spreader or deck spreader doesn't necessarily need to terminate at the connection to rigging.
