RSI 11 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- RSI 11.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board and on the http://www.sailing.org/worldcup/onb.php. Notices may also be posted at other locations. These are located at the results office notice board, Notice board located at the Royal Yacht Club of Victoria and the notice board located at Elwood Sailing Club for the kiteboards. Failure to post a notice at these other locations will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.
- RSI 11.2 Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagpoles located on the South West Cnr of the RMYS boat yard and in the launching area for the Kites and flag pole on the lawn area at RYCof V for the Paralympic classes.
- RSI 11.3 There will be a daily morning meeting with team leaders/coaches at 1030 in the upstairs member's lounge of the Royal Melbourne Yacht Squadron, St Kilda
- RSI 11.4 When flag AP is displayed ashore, "1 minute" is replaced with:
 - a) not less than 30 minutes for course areas in Royal Melbourne St Kilda Area
 - b) not less than 30 minutes for course areas in Royal Yacht Club Williamstown Area;
 - c) not less than 15 minutes for the Formula Kite".

RSI 13 MARKS

RSI 13.1 Marks 1, 2, 3, and 4, or associated gate marks, shall be inflatable cylindrical marks and will be as follows:

- RSI 13.4 Offset marks will be the same (colour and shape) as Marks 1.
- RSI 13.5 For 49er FX only, Mark 1 will be green and the New Mark will be green with a white band.
- RSI 13.6 The starting and finishing line marks will be race committee vessels, inflatable marks or a spar buoy with an orange flag.
- RSI 13.7 Inflatable starting line marks, when used, will be the same as the course area marks

 Inflatable finishing line marks, when used, will be the Black white chequered conical buoys.
- RSI 13.8 Change of course marks will be the same as the course area marks with a Black Band.
- RS1 14.3 The provisional race schedule, including the time of the first warning signals, and assignments of Events to course areas will be posted as RSI Addendum 3 no later than one week before the first race of each Round.
- RSI 14.3.1 An update to RSI Addendum 3 will be posted daily no later than 2000 on the previous evening of any race affected.

RSI 20 PROTESTS, PENALTIES and REQUESTS for REDRESS

- RSI 20.1 a) For fleets racing the protest time limit is 60 minutes after the last boat has finished her last race of the day.
 - b) For Formula Kite, the protest time limit is 90 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day.


