Current Position

A replacement form for the current Protest Form was approved in 2018 and also a statement to be included in the RRS 'A version of this form is available on the World Sailing website under Racing Rules.' was also approved.

Reasons

- 1. These forms are currently in use at many events.
- 2. Producing the decisions in electronic format enables the completed decision to be posted on electronic notice board and sent by electronic means to the parties.
- 3. A full checklist for hearings has been used at major event for more than three Olympic cycles. All of these checks are equally appropriate for all hearings at all levels and help protest committees to avoid procedural errors. This will help reduce the number of appeals and provide a better service to competitors.
