The following amendments to the Class Rules have been approved by the Class Rules Sub-Committee to be effective 24 December 2010.

Rule B.2.2

Amendment: Delete “forestay” from list of equipment required to carry ICA 9er IHC sticker.

Rule C.1.1(b)

Amendment: Add new rule to read as follows:

“If the wind is consistently 10 knots or above, measured at deck level, the Race Committee may permit “pumping, rocking and ooching” as stated in Appendix P5 of the RRS. If the Race Committee display Code Flag “O” before or with the warning signal, these actions are permitted from the preparatory signal.

Rule C.1.1(c)

Amendment: Add new rule to read as follows:

“RRS 49.1 is amended such that 1 member of the **crew** may use a trapeze.”

Rule C.7.1(f)(iii)

Amendment: Add new part (iii) rule to read as follows:

“(iii) for the purpose of converting to the 29erXX racing configuration.”

Rule C.7.1(g)

Amendment: Delete current rule and replace with the following and re-order remaining rules:

“The **daggerboard** case may only be packed with a soft carpet of felt material such packing shall not extend less than 20mm or more than 100mm from the top and bottom of the case. Packing may be fixed with either glue or tape.”

Rule C.9.1(f)

Amendment: Delete current rule and replace with the following:

“Tufts or ribbons attached to the **rigging** are permitted.”

Rule C.9.6(a)(i)

Amendment: Delete the first sentence of the rule and replace “3500mm” with “3350mm” in the last sentence so the rule now reads as follows:
“Trapeze lines shall include a minimum of 3350mm of stainless steel wire”.

Rule C.10.3 (a)

Amendment: Delete existing rule and replace with the following:

- (i) The national letters and the **sail** numbers shall be black and shall comply with the RRS except where specified in C.10.3 (ii).
- (ii) National letters shall be placed in front of the sail numbers and both shall comply with the specifications in the RRS Appendix G1.2 for boats under 3.5 metres.
