C.2 CLASSIC DISCIPLINE

Amend to add:

C.2.1.1 Definitions

- (a) Classic- A classic boat fulfils all class rules and the additional rules described in C.2
- (b) Jumping- The movement of the **boat** in which both **hulls** are out of the water completely for a brief period of time.
- (c) Irregular- Occurring at aperiodic intervals: not continuous, steady or stable.

C.2.1.2 Classic Boat Limitations

- (a) A **boa**t sailing in the classic discipline shall keep at least one **hull** in the water at all times, except while irregular jumping.
- (b) Any adjustment of **rudder** rake and/or any **hydrofoi**l attached to the **rudder** whilst racing is not allowed.
- (c) Daggerboards have to have either a straight leading & trailing edge or the radius of the chord of the leading edge is to be a constant curve of not less than 1.190m.
- (d) In any position, no part of the daggerboard shall exceed the transverse projection of a vertical arc of .780m radius centered at the lowest **hull** point at the leading edge of the daggerboard case.
