ANNUAL REPORT to ISAF 2015

During the latter part of 2014 and the first 9 months of 2015 there has been much activity in the area of Ocean Record attempts with an increasing emphasis on campaigns concentrating solely on records. The requirements for this are a fast stable yacht, a brave fit crew, a skilled resourceful skipper, an expert navigator and a willingness to wait on standby until the right weather window appears, sometimes for extended periods.

The most prominent campaign was by the team sailing the large trimaran "Lending Club", well known previously as Banque Populaire 7. This yacht attempted 3 World Records (Cowes to Dinard, Newport to Bermuda and the Transpac) during 2015 and broke the records for each by considerable margins.

The Fastnet record fell to another successful record attempting team, that of Phaedo 3, who also gathered the Antigua to Newport record and the Plymouth to La Rochelle record during this year.

The development of racing yachts continues unabated and one of the greatest attractions for the new yacht is to go for a world sailing record. Hence we had Oman Sail - a MOD 70 - breaking the Around Ireland record, Spindrift breaking the Cadiz to San Salvador record and Comanche establishing a new monohull 24 hour record.

It is too early in the year when writing this report to give results for the Around the World attempts, but there are 2 high profile yachts, with the ability to break the existing record of 45 days, already making preparations for the attempts at the end of this year.

In the area of the Windsurfers and Kitesurfers there were the now regular speed trials in Luderitz Namibia, where the intense competition for National Speed records continues unabated. During November and December 2014 a total of 9 National Records were broken - those of Italy, Austria, Czechoslovakia, Fiji, Russia, Sweden, Germany, Serbia and Switzerland. This popular and well attended event is due to take place again in November 2015.

So, my report this year is one of continuing activity and I look forward to more records being claimed in 2016.
