The following amendments to the Class Rules have been approved by the Class Rules Sub-Committee to be effective 1 October 2014.

General Rule 17.7

Amendment: Delete current rule and replace with new rule to read as follows:

17.7 For the purpose of Youth and/or Junior Events, the following applies unless otherwise prescribed in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions:

- a) Competitors for Youth series shall be under the age of 21 years of age on 31 December of the year the event starts.
- b) Competitors for Junior series shall be under the age of 16 years of age on 31 December of the year the event starts.
- c) For ISAF Events and qualification series up to ISAF Events (or events using the ISAF age definition) all competitors shall be under the age of 19 years on 31 December of the year of the event.

Hobie 16: Class Rule 9

Amendment: Delete current rule and replace with new rule to read as follows:

A maximum of two trapeze wires are allowed on each side of the boat. Trapeze wires shall be of stainless steel wire of not less than 2.38 mm diameter. The minimum length of the trapeze wire, including shackles, shall be from the bearing point on the mast tang to a point 1250 mm above the base of the mast extrusion. Adjustable systems may be attached to the trapeze wire shackled to the mast tang.
