

2021 - 2022 Grouping of World Sailing International Judges

The World Sailing grouping system identifies International Judges that World Sailing can appoint to major World Sailing events and Olympic class events in two specific capacities:

- a) Chief judge: judges who have the capability and experience to act as jury chairman at the Olympic Sailing Competition, World Sailing's 4-yearly Sailing World Championships and annual Sailing World Cup events, and Olympic Class World Championships.
- b) Lead judge: judges who have the capability and experience to act as a senior member of the jury at the above regattas and World Sailing's Youth World Championships.
