



2019 – 2020 Grouping of World Sailing International Race Officers

The World Sailing grouping system identifies International Race Officers that World Sailing can appoint to major World Sailing events and Olympic class events in two specific capacities:

- a) Chief/PRO: race officers who have the capability and experience to act as Principal Race Officer at the Olympic Sailing Competition, World Sailing's 4-yearly Sailing World Championships and annual Sailing World Cup events, and Olympic Class World Championships.
- b) Lead/Course Rep: race officers who have the capability and experience to act as a senior member of the race committee at the above regattas and World Sailing's Youth World Championships.
