

First Application and Reapplication for Status as International Race Officer - List of Events

List the four most important WS Events, World, Continental, or equivalent events, during the past four years in which you were a Course Race Officer (CRO), or Course Representative (CR) in charge of the conduct of racing on your course. Not with standing this requirement, a candidate may count no more than two events in a 4 year period at which he/she served as:

- Principal Race Officer (PRO) responsible for overall on water management where there are multiple courses,
- Course Representative (CR) appointed by WS, an MNA, Class Association to oversee the work of the Race Committee on one course area,
- Deputy Race Officer (DRO) working on the main committee boat with the Course Race Officer,
- Appointed by WS as an International Technical Official (ITO) at the Olympic, Paralympic or Youth Olympic Games

Note:- If you are both PRO and CRO at an event, you should state that you were CRO in the "Your Role" column and put "Self" in the "Name of PRO" column only if there were multiple course. If there was only one course you are the CRO and there is no PRO.
