

INTERNATIONAL J/24 CLASS ASSOCIATION

The following amendments to the Class Rules have been approved to be effective 1st March 2003.

Rule 2.8.1

Amendment: Delete current rule and replace with the following words:

"The method of measurement shall be in accordance with the IJCA Measurement Manual."

Rule 3.3.4 (Keel)

Amendment: Delete current rule and replace with the following words:

"The surface of the keel, from the hull down, shall be fair in all planes. In addition, the leading and trailing edges shall be within 5mm of a straight line."

Rule - Plan C

Amendment: Plan C has been modified accordingly for consistency with Rule 3.3.4, and to add reference to the "hull intersect point".

Rule 3.6.5 (Sails)

Amendment: Add to the end of current rule the following words:

"...and secondary reinforcing of additional layers of cloth. Reinforcement, finishing materials or coating applied to the reinforcement shall not prevent the sail from being folded; all reinforcement shall be capable of being folded in any direction without damaging the fibres. (see sail diagram)."

New Class Rule

Rule 8.5 Restrictions when Racing

Amendment: Add new class rule as follows:

"The luff and foot of the mainsail when set shall be within the distinguishing bands as defined in Rules 3.5.2(d) and 3.5.5(c). "
