1. Opening of the Meeting

- (a) All welcomed by IJSC Chair Andrus Poksi.
TC and RN gave opening welcome speech thanking all sub-committee members for the work completed this year.
- (b) Attendees and Apologies – Apologies received from Tina Ortendahl, all other SC members present.
- (c) Obituaries - shared obituaries for all Race Officials who have passed in 2021, including IJ's Dick Van Eck, Alex McAuley, Hannes Diefenbach, Jack Lloyd and Miklós Németh.
- (d) Performance Investigations
MD gave a report of all performance investigations, noting 2 Reg 32 received this year and 3 investigations concluded from 2020.
GD – Highlighted the inclusion of outcome s on the website and questioned how long they should be displayed. MD confirmed she shall take forward to discuss with legal team.

3. Race Official Roles, Qualifications and Competences

- (a) To evaluate the current IJSC section of the 2021 RQC document, to note items of relevance for post conference discussion of proposals to ROC.

IJSC evaluated the RQC document and sent a draft to ROC of suggested amendments to the 2022 RQC document, prior to the meeting.

4. Education and Development

- (a) Seminars and Clinics

- i) To discuss clinic/seminar instructor list for 2022

AP confirmed instructor list for seminars to remain the same as 2021, but highlighted a review to take place annually and therefore appointment this year does not reflect automatic position for remainder of the quad.

Noted Rule 42 instructors and clinic instructors to be removed due to no clear purpose.

- ii) To begin initial discussion on education for 2022

AP gave a report from the 1 IJ seminar held in Tallinn in August 2021. Explained the link to an event allowed for reduced cost to WS but noted this requires instructors to be away from home for an extended period for an event and a seminar. NS – noted the importance for education to be collaborated with major events.

TC gave a view on behalf of the board highlighting the need of education to not be based on budget received in respect of how many seminars/ clinics can be run. TC encouraged the SC's to be proactive in bringing forward new ideas and project outside of the 'usual' framework emphasising the need to provide rationale on what these projects offer, and what challenges they overcome, to work towards the greater aims and objectives of the RO strategy.

NS – noted the importance for education to be collaborated with major events.
