



The following amendments to the Class Rules has been approved to be effective 15 December 2012.

Current Rule:

3.4 Tiller. The tiller shall be supplied only by the Builder. Any material may be added to the tiller for a maximum length of 16 inches to prevent chafing from contact with the bridle. The added material should be primarily for anti-chaffing rather than stiffening.

Current Rule:

3.7.1 The mainsheet may be any length and diameter. A purchase may not be used on the mainsheet. The trigger clip may be removed or replaced with an alternative clip of approximately the same size. A small running block may be used on the (rope) bridle with or without the clip.

Amended Rule:

3.7.1 The mainsheet may be any length and diameter. A purchase may not be used on the mainsheet. The trigger clip may be removed or replaced with an alternative clip of approximately the same size. A small running block may be used on the bridle with or without the clip.

Current Rule:

3.2.5 No modifications shall be allowed to the daggerboard shown on Rules 5 Figure 4. Refinishing and/or repairing are allowed provided that the dimensions are in accordance with the measurement diagram on Rule 5 Figure 4 and with any gauges the Class may use to define the original size and shape. Covering this daggerboard with fiberglass is prohibited.

Amended Rule:

3.2.5 Repair and preventive maintenance work is allowed provided the dimensions as shown in Rule 5 Figure 4 are maintained. Covering the daggerboard with fibreglass is prohibited.
