

## **INTERNATIONAL VAURIEN CLASS**

The following amendments to the Class Rules have been approved to be effective 1<sup>st</sup> March 2001.

### **Centre-board – Shape and Dimensions**

#### **Rule 3.2.2.**

**Amendment:** Delete the current rule and replace with the following words:

“The dimensions of the centre-board shall not exceed those given on the plans, and the centre-board shall be within 10 mm of the profile shown, when the trailing edge of the centre-board is coincidental with the trailing edge shown on the plans. The centre-board may be faired 80 mm from the edges as shown on the plans. A device 30 mm minimum dimensions shall be fixed to each side of the centre-board 30 mm from the trailing edge in order to comply with the maximum depth of immersion as shown on the plans.”

### **Centre-board – Hand hold**

#### **Rule 3.2.3.**

**Amendment:** Delete the current rule and replace with the following words:

“The system of the hand hold is free.”

### **Rudder – Shape and Dimensions**

#### **Rule 3.3.2.**

**Amendment:** Delete the current rule and replace with the following words:

“The dimensions of the rudder blade shall not exceed those given on the plans, and the blade shall be within 10 mm of the profile shown, when the trailing edge of the rudder is coincidental with the trailing edge shown on the plans...etc”

### **New Rule**

#### **Rule 3.8.11**

**Amendment:** Add the following new rule: “Rule 3.8.11 Compass may be of any type but shall show the bearing of the boat course only excluding any other indication (for example wind shift).”

### **Safety equipment**

#### **Rule 4.2.**

**Amendment:** Delete the current rule and replace with the following words:

“The safety equipment listed here shall be compulsory carried on board when racing:

- (i) Anchor or grapnel : minimum mass 2 kilograms, when required by the Organising Authority.
- (ii) Rope : minimum diameter 6 mm, minimum length 12 metres attached to the hull. The rope shall be attached to hull and anchor, when the latter is required by the Organising Authority.
- (iii) etc.
