

WORLD SAILING POLICY REGISTER
PROCEDURE FOR CLASS RULES INTERPRETATIONS

1. Procedures

- 1.1 A valid request for Class Rule interpretation received by the World Sailing Equipment Rules Sub-committee shall be considered by a panel comprising of:
 - (a) the Chair or Vice-Chair of the Equipment Rules Sub-committee;
 - (b) a technical representative of the World Sailing Class Association; and
 - (c) a member of the World Sailing technical staff.
- 1.2 The panel may amend or consolidate the original request to ensure clarity in the interpretation.
- 1.3 The interpretation will be determined by a simple majority vote of all panel members.
- 1.4 Interpretations shall be notified by World Sailing to the World Sailing Class Association / owners association making the request, all Member National Authorities, all international measurers and all licensed manufacturers.
